CONSULAR CARDS

All Cameroonian citizens are advised to take steps to acquire a consular card. Eligible applicants must register at the Embassy in Washington, DC and must reside within this Embassy's area of jurisdiction which includes: the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, MEXICO, COSTA RICA, and the COMMONWEALTH of the BAHAMAS.

- (1) PROCESSING TIME: Approximately SEVEN (07) business days from the time of reception of an admissible application file.
- (2) <u>APPLICATION PROCEDURE:</u> Until further notice, applications for consular cards must be submitted BY MAIL ONLY. Follow the steps (a), (b) and (c) below:

- (b) <u>Documents to submit:</u> Be advised that Incomplete applications will be returned and experience significant delays.
 - 1. One printed copy of the present form with section (2)(a) above filled out, as cover page for your application file.
 - 2. Notarized letter of request, handwritten or typed, addressed to the Ambassador of Cameroon, requesting for the issuance of a consular card. This request must be notarized by a notary public prior to mailing the application file to the Embassy.
 - 3. Copy of Cameroonian passport and entry visa in the United States or in the applicant's country of residence.
 - 4. Two (02) filled-out and signed copies of the "APPLICATION FOR CONSULAR CARD' form below.
 - 5. Two (02) identical passport-size recent color photographs with white background.
 Photo Requirements: Size: 2 inches by 2 inches; the head should make about 3/4 of the surface of the photo, should be positioned directly facing the camera, with the eyes open and looking at the camera; Natural facial expression (mouth closed, no smiling or frowning); Neck, chin, nose, forehead, and both ears clearly visible; Eyeglasses, face covering, and head/hair accessories prohibited.
 - 6. A \$54.54 postal money order payable to "Embassy of Cameroon".
 - 7. One (1) copy of a document confirming your residency status in the United States or in your country of residence:
 - > Photocopy (front and back) of the green card or the work permit
 - For international students: Copy of the most recent form I-20, and a Letter from the International Students' Office of the school confirming that the student's F-1 status is active.
 - ➤ For other cases: Copies of any available immigration notices/documents.
 - 8. Photocopy front and back of the applicant's Cameroonian birth National Identity Card AND/OR Cameroonian Birth Certificate.
 - **9.** Photocopy of the applicant's U.S. issued driver's license or state I.D. if available.
 - 10. Recent [less than 3 months old or still within the period of validity] proof of profession: Copy of diploma or professional certification, student I.D. and enrollment verification letter from the school for students, or copy of work ID and letter from the employer confirming the profession/title/position of the applicant, or copies of any other available documents.
 - 11. Consular Cards for minors (Under 21 years old): The application forms must be signed by a parent or a legal guardian and the nature of the relationship between the under-aged applicant and the signatory must be specified in parenthesis (Example: father, mother, or legal guardian); if the child is under the care of a legal guardian, photocopies of any documents assigning guardianship must be provided.
 - > Notarized letter of support from at least 1 parent/legal guardian + copy of passport or national identity card of that parent.
 - > Parent/legal guardians who are in Cameroon must provide a parental authorization legalized by the Police along with a copy of their valid national identity card OR of the identification page of their valid Cameroonian passport.
 - > Parent/legal guardians who are neither in Cameroon nor in the United States must legalize the parental authorization at the nearest Cameroonian Embassy/Consulate, and provide a certified copy of the identification page of their Cameroonian passport.
 - **12.** Married women: Photocopy of the marriage certificate Note: Women who went through a marriage that was terminated due to a divorce or the death of a former spouse must provide a copy of the divorce decree, or a copy of the death certificate, whichever applies.
 - 13. Any additional documents deemed necessary for the processing of the request.
- (c) HOW AND WHERE TO MAIL THE APPLICATION FILE?: 2 prepaid envelopes (Use FedEx, UPS or USPS) with tracking must be prepared:

 The first envelope must be addressed from the funeral home to the Embassy, and will serve to mail the file to the Embassy at:

The second prepaid envelope, addressed from the Embassy back to the funeral home, will serve to return the processed paperwork.

Please take extra care in making sure that the return envelope is prepaid, has a tracking number and is addressed correctly.
