PROCURATION/POWER OF ATTORNEY/LEGALIZATION OF SIGNATURE

The Embassy of Cameroon in the United States (Washington, DC) issues/performs various types of certifications and legalizations for applicants residing in our area of jurisdiction, which includes: the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, MEXICO, COSTA RICA, and the COMMONWEALTH of the BAHAMAS.

- ▲ BE ADVISED THAT THE EMBASSY OF CAMEROON IN THE UNITED STATES (WASHINGTON, DC) DOES NOT PERFORM LEGALIZATIONS/CERTIFICATIONS OF FOREIGN DOCUMENTS.
- (1) PROCESSING TIME: Approximately FIVE (05) business days from the time of reception of a complete application.
- (2) APPLICATION PROCEDURE: BY MAIL ONLY.
- (3) QUESTIONS? Send your inquiry/question by email to <u>cs@cameroonembassyusa.org</u>. Start the subject line of your email with the words "Legalization". In the body of the message, describe the problem/issue/question that you are inquiring about and ALWAYS INCLUDE A PHONE NUMBER WHERE YOU CAN BE REACHED. We will reply as soon as possible.
- (4) REQUIREMENTS: Incomplete applications will be rejected!

SUBMIT (1) COPY OF THIS PAGE ALONG WITH THE DOCUMENTATION BELOW:

- 1. A notarized written request addressed to the Ambassador: The applicant must ask in writing that a power of attorney be legalized, or that a legalization of signature be performed for their benefit In this request, the applicant should state for what purpose they will use the document requested, and include their contact information (complete address, phone number and email address).
- 2. The Document (Power of Attorney/Procuration/or other document to legalize) signed by the applicant The applicant may download/print and fill out the procuration/power of attorney in English or French (available below) OR write their own Document/Power of Attorney: when writing the Power of Attorney, please specify the type of ID (valid passport/National Identity Card), the number, date and place of issuance of said document, and the contact information (Complete address, phone number and email address) for the applicant themselves and for the beneficiary of the procuration/power of attorney;
 - The written procuration/power of attorney must NOT be notarized!
 - A For other types of certifications/legalizations not specified here, please contact the Consular Section prior to applying.
- 3. For both the applicant and the beneficiary: Copy of VALID passport identification page <u>AND/OR</u> Copy of valid Cameroonian National Identity card (front and back);
- 4. a. If requesting a Power of attorney for matters related to a bank account, a piece of land, or other type of property: Provide proof of ownership of the bank account (copy of bank statement, cancelled check, etc.), piece of land (copy of land title in owner's name), or proof of ownership of other type of property;
 - b. If requesting a parental authorization or power of attorney for matters related to the passport application of a minor child (under 21 years old) in Cameroon, provide a copy of the birth certificate of the child;
- 1. Copies of immigration documents indicating the applicant's residency status in the United States:

Proof of Residency Status in the United States:

- For US citizens, copy of the biodata page of their US passport;
- For permanent residents: photocopy of the green card;
- For applicants whose case is awaiting a final decision, or about to start: provide copies of any available documents justifying that a procedure of adjustment of status is in progress or about to start;
- For international students in American schools: **copy** of the most recent form I-20, along with a letter from the International Students Office of the school **confirming a current enrollment under the F-1 student status**;
- For other cases: provide a copy of any available immigration documents.
- 2. A \$5.46 money order or cashier's check payable to "Embassy of Cameroon". Payments with personal checks or business checks, credit cards or electronic payments ARE NOT accepted.
- Be advised that the Embassy will request for any additional document deemed necessary for the processing of the application.
